

# Disabling Pop-up Blockers

There are many pop-up blockers available. Here is a list of the most popular and how to disable them:

- **Google™ Toolbar**
- **Yahoo® Toolbar**
- **AOL® Toolbar**
- **Microsoft Windows XP SP2**
- **Pop-Up Stopper**
- **Mozilla**
- **Firefox**
- **Popup Manager (for Internet Explorer)**
- **Starware Toolbar (for Internet Explorer)**
- **Norton Internet Securities**

**Note:** There are many pop-up blocking utilities available - this is just a list of the most popular. One way to test if you have a popup blocker installed, or to test if it is working, navigate to <http://www.popupstest.com> and click on the Multi Pop-up link. It will open 10 pop-up windows; if it does not then you either have something blocking the pop-ups or an issue with Java.

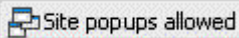
## Google™ Toolbar

If the Google Toolbar is blocking kunstverein.ch , there are three ways to disable it:

- To let a pop-up through on a one-time basis, press and hold the **Ctrl** key as you click on a link to navigate to a new page.
- The pop-up blocker can also remember certain sites (like myavc.avc.edu) and allow them to launch pop-up windows. To add kunstverein.ch to your list of permitted sites, click on the pop-up blocker button





while viewing the kunstverein.ch home page. The pop-up blocker button will appear as .



To completely disable the pop-up blocker, click the **Options** button in the Google toolbar and clear the checkbox next to **Popup Blocker** in the Accessories section.

## Yahoo® Toolbar

If Pop-Up Blocker is blocking kunstverein.ch, there are three ways to override it:

- Turn off Pop-Up Blocker by clicking the Pop-Up Blocker menu  and deselect **Enable Pop-Up Blocker**. The toolbar button changes to indicate that the blocker is disabled .
- Press and hold the **Ctrl** (or ) key while clicking a link to override Pop-Up Blocker and allow any pop-up windows resulting from the click.
- Add the source of the pop-up window to your **Allowed List** by clicking the Pop-Up Blocker menu and selecting **Always Allow Pop-Ups From....**  
Then select kunstverein.ch  
from the **Sources of Recently Blocked Pop-Ups** list and click **Allow**.

## AOL® Toolbar

1. Click **Settings** on the AOL toolbar.
2. Click **Pop-Ups** in the **Essentials** tab.
3. In the **Web Pop-Ups** tab of the **Pop-Up Control Settings** window, select **Allow Web pop-ups from these sites** from the available options.
4. Enter **myavc.avc.edu** and click **Add**. Click **Save**.
5. Enter **mail.avc.edu** and click **Add**. Click **Save**.

## Microsoft Windows XP SP2

When you install the Windows XP Service Pack 2 (SP2), Pop-up Blocker is automatically turned on in Internet Explorer and set to the medium setting, which means that it will block most automatic pop-ups. To allow Pop-ups from kunstverein.ch:

1. Launch an Internet Explorer browser window.
2. In the **Tools** toolbar menu, point to **Pop-up Blocker**, and then click **Pop-up Blocker Settings**.
3. Type kunstverein.ch in the **Address of Web site to allow** box, and then click **Add**. Click the **Close** button to exit.

## Pop-Up Stopper

If you have Pop-Up Stopper, an icon will appear in the bottom right hand corner of your screen.

1. To disable the blocker, right-click on the Pop-Up Stopper software icon.
2. Un-check the checkbox next to **Enable pop-up blocking**.
3. You can re-enable the software when you are done using kunstverein.ch.

## Mozilla

1. Open the **Edit** toolbar menu and choose the **Preferences** option.
2. On the right-hand column, under the **Privacy & Security Preferences** category, click on the **Popup Windows** topic. (If no sub-categories are visible, double-click on the title **Privacy & Security** to expand the list.)
3. You can either de-select the box next to **Block unrequested popup windows** to completely disable the pop-up blocking software, or add kunstverein.ch to a list of allowed sites.
4. To do this, click the **Allowed Sites...** button, type kunstverein.ch into the text field, and then click the **Add**. Click **OK**.
5. An alternative method of doing this is to browse to the kunstverein.ch website, and then click on the **Tools** toolbar menu. Choose **Popup Manager** and then select the **Allow Popus From This Site** option.

## Firefox

1. Go to the **Tools** toolbar menu and select **Options....**
2. When the **Options** window opens, click on the **Web features** icon in the left-hand panel.
3. Uncheck the box next to **Block Popup Windows**. Then, click the **OK** button to exit the **Options** window.
4. Alternatively, you can leave the **Block Popup Windows** box checked and click on the **Allowed Sites** button to the right of it. In the **Allowed Sites** window that opens, type kunstverein.ch in the text field beneath **Address of the web site**. Click the **Allow** button to the right of the text field and then click **OK**.

## Popup Manager (for Internet Explorer)

1. Launch a new Internet Explorer browser window and navigate to **http://www.kunstverein.ch**
2. Right-click with your mouse on the small color-coded area in the bottom left corner of your browser window. This bar of color will appear either red or green and is called a "widget".
3. In the resulting drop-down menu, select the option to **Allow Popups from**

**http://www.kunstverein.ch**

**Note:** In order to enable popups on an individual basis, press the **Ctrl** key while clicking on whatever is initiating the desired popup window.

## Starware Toolbar (for Internet Explorer)

- To allow popups from kunstverein.ch, launch a new Internet Explorer browser window and navigate to kunstverein.ch. Once you are on the kunstverein.ch om  on the Popup Blocker button in the Starware Toolbar. Once you do, the toolbar button will change to indicate that popups will now be allowed from kunstver .
- To completely disable the popup blocker, click on the arrow next to the Starware logo on the left-hand end of the toolbar. This will display the main menu; select the **Preferences...** option from the resulting drop-down list. In the message window that appears, uncheck the box to **Enable Popup Blocker**. Click **OK** to close the window.

## Norton Internet Securities

One of the more common popup blockers now is included in Norton's Internet Security suite.

One of the easiest ways to identify if you have Norton's Internet Security suite is to locate the icon in the system tray (see image below). This is also how you can disable it temporarily.

To disable it:

1. Right click on the icon
2. Choose **Disable** from the menu
